Translation of the Verses from the Quran

All Praise is due to Allah. So we praise him. We seek Security and assistance only from him. It is only from Allah we seek the straight path we totally submit ourselves to Allah. We seek refuge in Allah from the evil of our self and from the evil consequences of our deeds. There is none to lead astray whom Allah has guided to the straight path and there is none to guide him aright whom Allah leads astray. We bear witness that there is no God but Allah, and that Mohamed is the messenger of Allah. May peace and blessing of Allah be upon prophet Mohamed and his family and his Companions?

The subject matter of the sermon.

Marriage is a scared contract established in the Islamic law (shariath) for the purpose of, maintaining the heredity of ma kind. In which parties, the man and wife are held together in agreement to protect and respect and be responsible by the law to honor the promise of union of them in marriage.

Marriage in the religion of Islam is the lawful union of the man and a woman, thereby unifying their lives into one. After marriage, happiness received to the other. Sorrow or adversity met by



One person is shared with the other in the same manner. Marriage, is based on three principals are maintained within the frame work of the principals of Islam.

Therefore I advice you, both to abide by the conditions under which you enter in to this marriage, based on principles if the religion and morality, in that both of you should love, and be faithful and honest with each other, respect and trust each other, and live in peace and harmony. None of you should cause any harm to the other, in way of hurting or injuring the other or cause pain in any manner which may affect or destroy the harmonious relationship that should be maintained with each other.

The wife should uphold her husband in everything he does and respect and obey him as long as he holds to principles of Islam in what he does.

The husband too shall treat the wife nobly and give respect to her and should remain faithful to the wife.

Both the parties should take their varied responsibilities bestowed on to them in good spirit and should carry their respective duties, obligations. That is required of them both in their lives together at all times.

When the couple is blessed with children, both husband and wife should share equally in the duties and responsibilities of bringing up the children in an appropriate manner, and seek to maintain and protect the rights of the children.

Advising you as above I now solemnize the contract of your marriage:

The Quran verses to be read by

For sum of rupees as bridal price, in accordance with the Islamic law, seeking Allah's blessing pronounce you as husband and wife.

By (to be read after the official, accepting shaanee as his wife:

"Alhugandhu Anbi Qaboolu Kofin" – (I accept her, (.....) as my wife).

The official continues blessing the couple and finish off with a short prayer from the holy Ouran:

May Allah bless you both with this marriage just contracted between you from this marriage may Allah grant you a life of goodness, prosperity, and bless you with children and continuity of your progeny.

Translation of the Quranic verse: (the very last)

Translation of the recitation: our lord give us good in this world and good in the hereafter and save us from the torment of the fire, and the peace be upon our Prophet Mohammed and his companions, and glory to the lord, the lord of honor and power! (He is free) from what they describe (to him) and peace be upon the messengers and praise to Allah, the lord and cherisher of the world.
